by exhibiting and coming along.

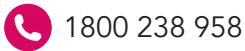
Every person living with a disability has different needs and will make different choices about how they wish to live their life.

Happy Paws Happy Hearts (HPPH) is a national not-for-profit connecting socially isolated people with rescue animals to create positive change.

Partnering with organisations like Dogs' Homes of Tasmania and Ten Lives Cat Centre, HPPH runs hands-on programs where participants build confidence, social connection and life skills while helping rescue animals prepare for adoption.

HPPH supports people with disability, veterans, at-risk youth and older Australians, using a unique model that harnesses the magic of the human-animal bond to build pathways to volunteering, education and employment.

We offer five programs ranging from gentle, sensory-based animal engagement to hands-on shelter work — from making enrichment items, and basic shelter tasks like laundry, through to safe dog handling. Each program builds communication, confidence and independence through purposeful, routine-based activity.

Programs are delivered in structured weekly sessions that build functional capacity across social, emotional, vocational and daily living domains. Supported by volunteers, trained staff and support workers, participants work in small groups on tasks that grow in complexity as skills and confidence develop. And rolling enrolment means participants can join anytime and stay as long as the program benefits their goals. Monthly learning modules introduce changing themes, reinforced through hands-on shelter activities.

HPPH is an unregistered NDIS provider, welcoming Self- or Plan-Managed NDIS participants, privately funded clients, and DVA-funded clients. Fees depend on the enrolled course – please visit www.hphhfoundation.org/participant-form

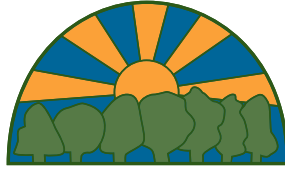
